SHARING OF INFORMATION

The contents of this safety plan will be posted outside the dining hall main entrance and on the Pine Orchard Camp Facebook group. Anyone coming on the grounds will be instructed by the Facebook post and by the Camp Manager or his designate to adhere by the guidelines outlined in this plan.

Updates to any governmental regulations will be monitored by the Camp Manager and the Chair of Operations both on the Ontario government site and on the York Region site. Any revisions based on changes to the government regulations will be shared by the Camp Manager and/or Chairman of Operations with Wade Elford so that this safety plan can be revised. Any revisions to the safety plan will be posted both outside the dining hall and on the Facebook group.

SCREENING

A screening table will be set up outside on the patio at the main entrance to the dining hall. The following will be available at this screening table:

- i. alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol content
- ii. Covid-19 Sign-in Screening forms for completion
- iii. Covid-19 Screening poster

The Camp Manager or designate will ensure the above items are provided at the screening table.

Individuals wanting to come on the grounds must be screened for COVID-19. This will be done using two methods:

- i. Online pre-screening before coming to the camp.

A link will be provided on the Pine Orchard Camp Facebook group for anyone wanting to come to the camp. Individuals will complete the Ontario government's online screening questions. If a "You can go" result is obtained, the individual will check off the relevant box on the COVID-19 Sign-in Screening Form when he/she arrives at the camp. Anyone with a "Do not go" result will not be permitted to come on the grounds.

ii. On-site screening

Individuals will complete a COVID-19 Sign-in Screening Form available at the screening table outside the dining hall. If any of the conditions are not met, the individual will not be permitted on the grounds. These forms will also serve as a record of who is on the grounds each day. Completed forms will be kept on file in the camp office by the Camp Manager or designate.

CONTROLLING THE RISK OF TRANSMISSION

Before coming to the camp, anyone wanting to come on the grounds MUST contact the Camp Manager by either calling or texting 905-473-5660. This is to allow the Camp Manager to control the number of people at the camp at any given time based on present regulations.

Physical distancing of 2 metres will be maintained between household groups at all times.

Pool times will be booked for a maximum of 13 people in the pool through the Camp Manager or designate. Parents/guardians supervising children who are in the pool will physically distance themselves while inside the pool fence enclosure.

Masks will be worn whenever physical distancing of 2 metres is not possible.

Washrooms and showers will be sanitized twice daily by camp staff.

Washroom and shower facilities will be sanitized after each use by the individual using them using the disinfectants provided in each area. Procedures for sanitizing will be posted in each area.

Washrooms in the dining hall will be designated for use by the Camp Manager and his immediate household group only.

POTENTIAL CASES OR SUSPECTED EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

Anyone who has been on the grounds and has tested positive for COVID-19 will notify the Camp Manager. Public health will work with the individual if anyone needs to be notified. The Camp Manager can help assist with contact information using the COVID-19 Sign-in Screening Forms for the dates the individual was on the grounds.

No one is permitted to self-isolate on the grounds. Anyone testing positive must self-isolate at another location.
